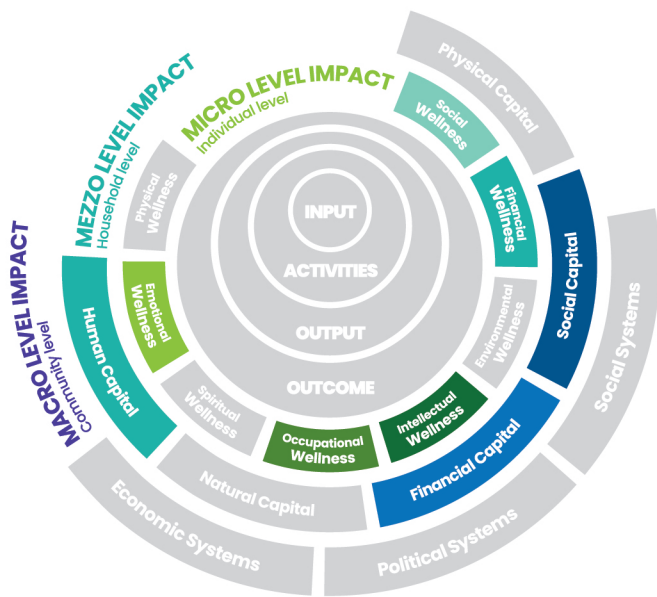
Programme Overview

The Anglo American Platinum (AAP) Programme was focused on women and young people who are at risk or affected by gender-based violence and harassment (GBVH) in six sites within four districts, namely Capricorn (Limpopo), Sekhukhune (Limpopo), Waterberg (Limpopo), and Bojanala (North West). These rural mining areas present a complex socio-economic landscape marked by poverty, unemployment, social exclusion, and economic marginalization.

Since adolescent young girls and women are most vulnerable to poverty and other social ills, often leading to GBVH and HIV, the program aimed to reduce participants' vulnerability risks by enhancing their safety, health, and economic well-being. The programme provided training towards livelihood skills, access to livelihood follow-on career development opportunities, and livelihood coaching and financial support to access follow-on career opportunities.
